ENTRY TO ADELAIDE MOTORSPORT PARK

- Entry to AMP for competition vehicles will be through the Gate B, Pit Entry Gate, not Main Gate.

- Email Nomination Form to baap@adam.com.au and pay the Nomination Fee of \$80 by credit card, the \$25 Competitor Annual Licence paid to AASA, as per details on front page of Nomination Form
- Drop Nomination Form into Adelaide Motorsport Park Office, Service Gate, 173 Supple Road, Waterloo Corner, S.A., 5110, Monday – Friday 9am – 4.00pm, Ph:(08)8380 8390.
- Payment with filled out Entry Form is advisable to guarantee place in competition

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- No alcohol or glass to be brought into the Adelaide Motorsport Park complex
- No alcohol permitted in the Pit Area
- All persons in the Pit Area must have closed in footwear

BURNOUT REGULATIONS

REQUIREMENTS

- All Drivers are to complete Nomination Form and sign the Indemnity Acknowledgement before entering the Pit Area
 - Any false information on the Entry Form may result in the Driver being banned from future events
- All Drivers and Passengers must wear long sleeved shirts, long trousers and covered footwear
 - No thongs, sandals, shorts and T shirts allowed
 - No nylon clothing to be worn
 - See Appendix 4 Apparel Requirements AASA Website for Extreme Events-Club
- It is mandatory that seat belts are correctly fastened by the Driver and any Passenger during competition
- Helmets must be worn by both the Driver and any Passenger, must meet or exceed AS1698 standards, no "Skull Cap" style helmets, helmets must extend to cover the complete ear
- The maximum speed of vehicles within the Adelaide Motorsport Park complex and infield is 15 km/hr
- Burn Outs must cease and the vehicle leave the burn out pad immediately on the direction of the Official

VEHICLE AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- Each vehicle must comply with the AASA NCR's and the AASA Event Operations Manual
- Each vehicle must be competition ready with all loose items removed from the vehicle
- Each battery must be securely retained using steel clamps
- All fittings must be securely fastened with no fuel, oil or brake leaks
- Brake and headlights must be in working order
- Each supercharged car must have a Blower Restraint to SFI 14.1 or equivalent standard, unless the Supercharger is fitted entirely underneath the manufacturer's unmodified steel bonnet
- Each tyre must be in good condition with no steel belts or canvas showing at the commencement of each session
- Each driven wheel shall have an outer rim section of rolled metal, either steel or aluminium alloy. Fully cast wheels are not acceptable without specific approval from the Organisers
- Each vehicle must be fitted with a Maximum 1 litre overflow or water catch bottle
- There must be no oil leaks from the rocker covers
- All vehicles must have a bonnet fitted unless permitted by the Organiser. If no bonnet is fitted, all ancillary drive belts must be covered
- Structural rust is not acceptable
- No wheel weights are permitted on driven wheels for the duration of the competition
- Each brake and fuel line must be at a safe distance from the exhaust and driven wheels
- Each hole in the firewall is to be plugged
- Where wheel arches are cut to fit tyres, each subsequent opening so created shall be closed to ensure separation between burnt rubber and the fuel tank
- Each vehicle must be fitted with a tail shaft loop immediately behind the gearbox
- Each vehicle with mechanically operated throttles must be fitted with secondary accelerator return springs
- Each vehicle equipped with N2O must have all holed plugged in the rear parcel shelves and rear firewall
- Each vehicle equipped with N2O must have an approved sticker of yellow printed with black text

RULES OF COMPETITION

- The intention is to provide as much smoke as possible, without hesitation, in the allocated time limit of 60 seconds
- Headlights must be on
- Any Driver failing to keep within the defined area will be automatically disqualified
- No static burnouts permitted as vehicle must keep moving
 - Long static burnouts will result in a loss of points
- If a tyre or engine blows vehicle is to stop immediately
- Burnouts on pit roads or any other area (other than the designated burnout area) will result in the Driver and vehicle removed from Adelaide Motorsport Park Complex and banned from competing in future events
 - The cost of any damage will be charged to the Driver
- Drivers must not consume alcohol for a minimum of 12 hours prior to or during the event, if tested must register below BAC 0.01
- No alcohol or glass is to be brought into the Adelaide Motorsport Park Complex
- Drivers must follow the requests of Officials

CLASS ORDER AND AWARDS

Class Order First Round

- 4 Cyl, 6 Cyl, V8's, followed by Masters
After 1st round, break of 15 minutes

Class Order Second Round

- 4 Cyl, 6 Cyl, V8's, followed by Masters
After 2nd round, break of 15 minutes

Class Finals

4 Cylinder – Top 3 to compete

6 Cylinder – Top 5 to compete

V8 – Top 5 to compete

After Class Finals, break of 15 minutes

\$10,000 to Win Masters Final

- Top 10 Masters plus Top car from 4 Cyl class, and Top 2 from 6 Cyl class, and Top 3 from V8 class

NOTE: The 4cyl 6cyl and V8's in the Masters Final Shootout are from the rounds not the winners from finals!

1st, 2nd after 2 Rounds 6cyl

1st, 2nd 3rd after 2 Rounds V8
